Region 4 Mobile Crisis Responder (MCR) Training Overview & Expectations

Why MCR Training?

To equip mobile crisis and communitybased stabilization staff with the skills, competencies and knowledge necessary to successful provide mobile crisis and community-based stabilization services.

Who is eligible to be trained?

All current mobile crisis private providers who have a signed MOU with Region 4.

In order to successfully complete the training, participants will need to:

- Complete each assigned pre-test
- Complete the pre and post work for each of the modules spread throughout 8 days of training
- Complete each assigned post-test

MCR Participant Expectations

Training Overview:

- The curriculum consists of modules for both youth and adult mobile crisis response services approximately **48 hours total of direct instruction**, split into 8 training days.
- All participants will take the 8-day course in its entirety. Upon completion of all 8 days of training, participants will be certified in both youth and adult MCR services.
- Each module will be assigned in the online learning management system
- Pre-work is approximately 2-3 hours per module
- Post-work is approximately 1-2 hours per module

Participant Expectations:

- When on Zoom, it is mandatory for participants to have cameras on
- Participants will actively engage in Zoom breakout room activities
- The pre-work and pre-test are completed before the start of each module
- The post-test will be assigned immediately upon completing the content and trainers will give time at the end of the module for participants to complete/pass the test that same day. Post-test must be completed within 24 hours of module.
